*Subject : (i) Payment of balance arrear arising out of the revision of pension/family pension of the Assam Government pensioners/ family pensioners/extra-ordinary pension holders for the period from 01-04-2017 to 30-06-2017; and
(ii) Payment of additional quantum of pension with effect from 01-04-2016 along with arrear accrued thereon.*


In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Assam/Vol.-VIII/Revision/136 dated 31-10-2017 and Pen. Co-ordn./Assam/Vol.-VIII/DR&Arrear/200 dated 19-02-2018, this is to state that the Government of Assam in their Pension and Public Grievances Department O.M. No. PPG(P)140/2017/13 dated 07-12-2017 has released the balance arrear accrued for the period 01-04-2017 to 30-06-2017, arising out of revision of pension/family pension of the Assam Government pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-04-2016.

2. Besides, in continuation to this office circular dated 31-10-2017 *ibid*, this is to state that the Government of Assam in their said O.M. dated 07-12-2017 has decided that all pensioners who have attained 80 years of age or more as on 01-04-2016, their pension shall be increased by 20% calculated on the basic pension drawn by the pensioner on 01-04-2016. The effective date for allowing the benefits of additional quantum of pension shall be 01-04-2016 and any arrear accrued in this regard with effect from 01-04-2016 shall be paid to the eligible pensioners.

3. Having been authorized by the Accountant General (A&E), Assam, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of balance arrear with effect from 01-04-2017 to 30-06-2017 to all Assam Government pensioners/family pensioners and additional quantum of pension as well as arrear accrued, if any, with effect from 01-04-2016 to the eligible Assam Government pensioners as per instructions laid down above after proper adjustment.

4. The charges on this accounts are debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S.A/cs.; Government of Assam etc."
