Subject: Grant of Dearness Relief with effect from 01-01-2018, 01-07-2018, 01-01-2019, 01-07-2019, 01-01-2020 and 01-07-2020 to the Kerala Government service pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/family pensioners coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Scheme as well as pensioners/family pensioners drawing pension/family pension at Central rates.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Kerala/Vol.VIII/DR/99 dated 24-08-2018, this is to state that the Government of Kerala in their GO (P) Nos. 44/2019/Fin. dated 04-04-2019 and 25/2021/Fin. dated 08-02-2021 has revised the rate of dearness relief payable to their different categories of pension/family pension as under:

revised as per GO (P) No. 9/2016/Fin. dated 20-01-2019 (circulated vide No. Pen. Co-ordn./Kerala/Vol.-VIII/Revision/47 dated 27-06-2016) the revised rates of dearness rener win to as below:

Co-ordn./Kerala/Vol.VI/DR & Prov. Rev./66 dated 02-07-2007) and whose pension has not undergone revision as per G O (P) No. 211/2011/Fin. dated 07-05-2011 (this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Kerala/Vol.-VII/Revision-UGC/114 dated 30-08-2011) the revised rates of dearness relief will be as below:

Co-ordn./Kerala/Vol.VII/Rev-DIIA&MA/106 dated 23-08-2011) and the pensioners/family pensioners coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who retired after 01-07-2004 and whose pension has been revised as per G O (P) No. 84/2007/Fin. dated 01-03-2007 and has not undergone revision as per G O (P) No. 211/2011/Fin. dated 07-05-2011 (aforesaid circular dated 30-08-2011), dearness relief will be payable as below:

Co-ordn./Kerala/Vol.-VI/Revision/178 dated 18-01-2007) and are drawing pension/family pension as per pension revision 1997 and in respect of pensioners coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes whose pension has not undergone revision as per G O (P) No. 81/2007/Fin. dated 28-02-2007 (circulated vide aforesaid circular dated 02-07-2007) or G O (P) No. 84/2007/Fin. dated 01-03-2007, dearness relief will be payable as below:

This will be applicable only till such time as the date of effect of option for Pension Revision 2004, after which the dearness relief payable will be as indicated in para (iii) above and after the date of effect of option for Pension Revision 2009, dearness relief will be payable as indicated in para 1(ii) above.

2. In respect of Ex-Chairman and Members of Kerala Public Service Commission, rate of

dearness relief will be revised with effect from 01-01-2018 as follows: -

In respect of the teaching staff coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have changed over to revised UGC/AICTE scale from 01-01-2006 and for those retired thereafter and to all retired Kerala State Judicial Officers whose pension has been revised as per G O Ms. No. 236/10/Home dated 02-11-2010 (this office circular dated 23-08-2011 mentioned above), the rate of dearness relief will be revised as under:

The teaching staff coming under the UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Streams who have retired prior to 01-01-2006 and whose pension has been revised in terms of G O No. 211/2011/Fin. dated 07-05-2011 will also be eligible for dearness relief at the above rate.

- 4. Payment of dearness relief involving fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- 5. Having been authorized by the office of the Accountant General (A&E), Kerala in their authority Nos. P19/II/DRSSA-050/KER-DR/2019-20/0777 dated 09-07-2019 and P19/IV/DRSSA-07/2020-21/ dated 20-09-2021, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief to all eligible Kerala Government pensioners/family pensioners of aforesaid categories at the rate and from the date mentioned above after proper adjustment.
- 6. The charges on this account should be debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S. A/cs.; Government of Kerala etc."
