Subject : Enhancement of the monetary allowances for the recipients of President's Police Medal for Gallantry, Police Medal for Gallantry and Prime Minister's Police Medal for Life Saving with effect from 14-06-2018.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Manipur/Vol. IV/Police Medal/207 dated 18-02-2014, this is to state that in pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' letter No. 11026/03/2017-PMA dated 14-06-2018, Government of Manipur, Police Department in their Order No. E/35/72/2015-PHQ(Adm)/8785 dated 19-06-2018 have accorded sanction to the enhancement of monetary allowances attached to President's Police Medal for Gallantry, Police Medal for Gallantry and Prime Minister's Police Medal for Life Saving with effect from 14-06-2018 as under :

2. This order will be applicable only to those police personnel who had already been authorized their monetary allowances by the AG (A&E), Manipur.

3. The payment of the above allowance shall continue to be in force subject to all other terms and conditions contained in the respective Statutes and Rules governing the award of the above Medals.

Having been authorised by the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Manipur in their letter No. Pen-I/MAN-MA/2022-23/272 dated 21-03-2023, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of revised monetary allowances attached to President's Police Medal and Police Medal for Gallantry to all medal recipient pensioners of Government of Manipur as per instruction laid down above after proper adjustment.

5. The charges on this account are debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S. A/cs.; Government of Manipur etc."
