Subject : Grant of dearness relief to the Tamil Nadu Government pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2023.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Tamil Nadu/Vol.-VII/DR/87 dated 14-09-2023, this is to state that the Government of Tamil Nadu in their G.O.Ms. No. 310 dated 27-10-2023 has sanctioned dearness relief to their pensioners/family pensioners as under :

<i>Date of effect</i>	<i>Rate of dearness relief per month</i>
01-07-2023	46% of basic pension/family pension

2. The amount of dearness relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee if such fraction is 50 paise and above and shall be ignored if it is less than 50 paise.

3. The above dearness relief shall also apply to the retired teaching and non-teaching staff of aided educational institutions, employees under local bodies, employees governed by the University Grants Commission/All India Council for Technical Education scales of pay, Teachers/Physical Education Directors/Librarians in Village Assistants in Revenue Department, Noon Meal Organisers, Child Welfare Organisers, Anganwadi Workers, Cooks, Helpers, Panchayat Secretaries/Clerks in Village Panchayat under Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department.

4. The revised rates of dearness relief shall not be admissible to retired part time employees.

5. Having been authorized by the Accountant General (A&E), Tamil Nadu in their authority No. AG(A&E)/Pen-29/I/Mail/2023-24/33651 dated 22-11-2023, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief to the aforesaid categories of Tamil Nadu Government pensioners/family pensioners @ 46% on their basic pension/family pension with effect from 01-07-2023 after proper adjustment.

6. The charges on this accounts are debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S. A/cs.; Government of Tamil Nadu etc."
