Subject: Grant of dearness relief to the Tamil Nadu Government pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2023.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Tamil Nadu/Vol.-VII/DR/87 dated 14-09-2023, this is to state that the Government of Tamil Nadu in their G.O.Ms. No. 310 dated 27-10-2023 has sanctioned dearness relief to their pensioners/family pensioners as under:

Date of effect	Rate of dearness relief per month
01-07-2023	46% of basic pension/family pension

- 2. The amount of dearness relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee if such fraction is 50 paise and above and shall be ignored if it is less than 50 paise.
- 3. The above dearness relief shall also apply to the retired teaching and non-teaching staff of aided educational institutions, employees under local bodies, employees governed by the University Grants Commission/All India Council for Technical Education scales of pay, Teachers/Physical Education Directors/Librarians in Village Assistants in Revenue Department, Noon Meal Organisers, Child Welfare Organisers, Anganwadi Workers, Cooks, Helpers, Panchayat Secretaries/Clerks in Village Panchayat under Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department.
- 4. The revised rates of dearness relief shall not be admissible to retired part time employees.
- 5. Having been authorized by the Accountant General (A&E), Tamil Nadu in their authority No. AG(A&E)/Pen-29/I/Mail/2023-24/33651 dated 22-11-2023, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief to the aforesaid categories of Tamil Nadu Government pensioners/family pensioners @ 46% on their basic pension/family pension with effect from 01-07-2023 after proper adjustment.
- 6. The charges on this accounts are debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S. A/cs.; Government of Tamil Nadu etc."
