Subject : (i) Empanelment of Accredited Hospitals – Approval of 79 additional hospitals, inclusion of additional specialties in 19 hospitals and for deletion of 23 hospitals based on the recommendations of the Accreditation Committee under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Tamil Nadu Government pensioners/family pensioners; and (ii) Empanelment of Accredited Hospitals – approval of the accreditation committee for removal of closed hospitals from the empanelled list – deletion of 34 hospitals based on the recommendations of the Accreditation Committee under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Tamil Nadu Government pensioners/family pensioners.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Tamil Nadu/Vol.-VII/NHIS/166 dated 16-01-2024, this is to state that the Government of Tamil Nadu in their GO Ms. No. 227 dated 17-07-2023 has decided to include 79 new additional hospitals as approved network hospitals, additional specialties in 19 hospitals and for deletion 23 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Tamil Nadu Government pensioners/family pensioners as detailed in the Annexure I, II and III to that order.

2. Moreover, Government of Tamil Nadu in their GO Ms. No. 298 dated 12-10-2023 has decided to delete 34 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Tamil Nadu Government pensioners/family pensioners as detailed in the Annexure to that order.
