Subject: Grant of dearness relief to the Uttarakhand Government pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2023 and 01-01-2024.

Date: 01-05-2024

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Uttarakhand/Vol.-II/DR/66 dated 07-08-2023, this is to state that the Government of Uttarakhand in their FS O.M. Nos. 182101/XXVII(7)/E-22807/2022 dated 13-01-2024 and 199032/XXVII(7)/E-22807/2022 dated 14-03-2024 has decided to sanction dearness relief for their pensioners/family pensioners whose pension/family pension has been revised as per recommendation of the 7<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission at the rate and from the date as under:

Date of effect	Rate of dearness relief per month
01-07-2023	46% of basic pension/family pension
01-01-2024	50% of basic pension/family pension

2. Payment of dearness relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to next higher rupee.

- 3. These orders will also be applicable to such teaching and non-teaching pensioners of Institutions aided from the State of Uttarakhand under the Education/Technical Education Department whose pension/family pension is at par with the pensioners of the Government of Uttarakhand.
- 4. These orders will not be applicable to the Judges of High Court of Uttarakhand, Chairman and Members of Uttarakhand Public Service Commission, Civil/Family Pensioners of local bodies and Public Undertaking Corporation etc. In respect of such categories separate orders will be issued by the respective departments.
- 5. Having been authorised by the Accountant General (A&E), Uttarakhand in their authority No. P.A./Pension/Dearness Relief/Uttarakhand/2023-24/33 dated 04-04-2024, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief to all eligible Uttarakhand Government pensioners/family pensioners @ 46% and 50% on their basic pension/family pension with effect from 01-07-2023 and 01-01-2024 respectively after proper adjustment.
- 6. The charges on this account are debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S.A/cs.; Government of Uttarakhand etc."
