Sub: Notification of Divisional Accountant Grade Examination (DAGE) September- 2026 – reg

It is notified to all concerned that the Divisional Accountants Grade Examination (DAGE)-Sept.2026 will be held from **23.09.2026 to 28.09.2026**.

The Divisional Accountants (Probationers), subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned therein, should apply in the prescribed proforma through their respective Executive Engineers to appear in the above examination, so as to reach this office on or before **16.09.2026**, positively.

The examination will be conducted as per the instructions and guidelines issued by the Examination Wing of Headquarters Office vide Circular **No.726/06-Exam/Departmental Exam/ 2026 Dated: 10/09/2026**, already circulated through Office Order No. **27** dated 11.09.2026.

As regards exemption in different papers under the new syllabus, **Headquarters Circular No. 04 dated 09.10.2023** is enclosed herewith.

It has been observed that some Divisional Accountant (Probationers) do not take the examination seriously and, despite applying, do not appear. Therefore, the following is brought to the notice of all concerned Divisional Accountants (Probationers):

Instructions:

1. Candidates will ordinarily not be allowed more than three chances during the probation period. However, the Accountant General (A&E), at his sole discretion, may, in special circumstances, extend the probation period up to twice the normal period and allow up to three additional chances to deserving candidates. If the probation period is curtailed, the number of chances will be reduced proportionately. If a candidate fails to pass the examination within the admissible number of chances or does not avail the available chances, he/she shall be liable to be removed from service.
2. Counting of chances shall commence from the first examination held after a Divisional Accountant (Probationer) becomes eligible, irrespective of whether he/she actually appears. If a candidate is unable to appear for valid reasons, he/she must apply for exemption well in advance (at least two months before the examination). Such exemption will be granted only after the competent authority is satisfied about the genuineness of the reasons. Failure to obtain

such permission will result in the examination being counted as a chance.

3. Permission for non-appearance, if granted, will be valid only for that particular examination and will not be carried forward or adjusted for subsequent examinations. Absence in subsequent examinations will be counted as a chance.
4. Candidates who have already availed three normal chances must apply to the competent authority for additional chances in the prescribed proforma within the due date.
5. Applications received after the due date or in incomplete form will be rejected.
6. Eligible Divisional Accountants (Probationers) should appear in the examination in their own interest for retention in the grade. Failure to appear without proper permission will be treated as a chance.

Madam/Sir,

The syllabus of departmental examinations is revised from time to time according to departmental requirement on changed circumstances. In this regard, it is informed that with the changed audit/accounts environment, the **Competent Authority has approved the revised syllabus of 'Divisional Accountants Grade Examination' along with Paper-wise exemption matrix.** The revised syllabus and Paper-wise exemption matrix are enclosed herewith.

2. There are 7 papers in the revised syllabus of DAGE. Total marks in each paper is **100**. Pass/exemption marks in each paper is **45**. Negative marks for each wrong answer of MCQ is **0.25**. No negative mark for Conventional and Practical paper/part.

3. The DAGE in the revised syllabus will be conducted **twice** a year (as is being held at present as per Para 7.8 of MSO (Admn) Vol. I) centrally along with **SAS** examination. The **first** DAGE in the revised syllabus will be held along with **SAS Exam-2 of 2024**.
