Proceedings of the General Body Meeting of the Central Govt. Employees Welfare Coordination Committee (CGEWCC), Sikkim held on 15.12.2021

1. Finalization of the list of Gazetted/Restricted Holidays to be observed by all Central Government Offices located in the State of Sikkim for the year 2021

As per the instructions contained in Para-3.1 of Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Deptt. of Personnel & Training, Establishment (JCA-2) Section dated 8th June, 2021 (copy attached), the CGEWCC, Sikkim has selected the following three optional holidays in addition to the 14 compulsory holidays mentioned in Para 2 of DoPT circular to be observed as Gazetted Holiday during the year 2022 in all the Central Government Administrative Offices located in the State of Sikkim.

Further, the CGEWCC decided to observe the "Restricted Holidays during the year 2022 for administrative offices of Central Government located at Delhi/New Delhi" (enclosed as Annexure III), as Restricted Holidays by all Central Government Offices located in the State of Sikkim (except an additional day for Dussehra (Mahashtami) on October, 03, 2022 & Parsi New Year's Day/Nauraj, on August, 16, 2022, which are taken as Gazetted Holiday during the year 2022). In addition, to above mentioned Restricted Holidays as per Annexure III, the "Public Holidays and Restricted Holidays of the Government of Sikkim for the year 2022", declared by the Hon'ble Governor of Sikkim, will be observed as Restricted Holidays for all Central Government offices located in the State of Sikkim.

2. Finalization of Panel of Authorized Medical Attendant (AMAs) for the year 2022

The CGEWCC approved to continue the existing panel of Authorized Medical Attendants (AMAs) given in **Annexure IV** as AMA for the year 2022 for treatment of Central Government employees posted in Sikkim and their family.

In addition to the AMAs mentioned in Annexure IV, all the members and their families are also eligible to take treatment from the Central Referral Hospital, Manipal, Tadong, Sikkim and Other State Government Hospitals as per CS (MA) rule.

3. Contribution to Yearly Subscription

The Chairman requested all the member offices, who have not submitted their annual subscription dues for the year 2020-21 to submit their subscription of ₹ 500.00 (Rupees Five Hundred) only in cash to the Secretary, CGEWCC at the earliest. The yearly contribution of ₹ 500/- will be paid on behalf of individual Department for conducting meetings and for other welfare activities to be taken up by CGEWCC, Gangtok. The contribution given by the offices is official and not personnel, so it is to be paid to CGEWCC officially.
