| <b>AA</b>                | <b>Absolute Alcohol</b>  |
| <b>AL</b>                | <b>Alcoholic Litre</b> means a litre with reference to alcoholic content of the spirit.  |
| <b>ATL</b>               | <b>Alcohol Technologist Laboratories.</b>  |
| <b>BLF</b>               | <b>Basic Licence Fee</b>   |
| <b>BL</b>                | <b>Bulk Litre</b> means a litre with reference to the bulk or quantity of the contents   |
| <b>Brix</b>              | Density of solutions expressed in brix densitometric scale   |
| <b>CL</b>                | <b>Country Liquor</b> means plain or spiced spirit which has been made in India from material recognised as base of country spirit namely mahua, rice, gur or molasses |
| <b>COT</b>               | <b>Continuous Out Turn</b>   |
| <b>Distillation</b>      | Separation of alcohol contents from water present in wash by vaporization of the mixture   |
| <b>DEO</b>               | <b>District Excise Officer</b>   |
| <b>DEOs</b>              | <b>District Excise Offices</b>   |
| <b>Dip</b>               | Measurement of molasses present in molasses tank   |
| <b>EC</b>                | <b>Excise Commissioner</b>   |
| <b>ENA</b>               | <b>Extra Neutral Alcohol</b>   |
| <b>Fermentation</b>      | Process of producing alcohol and alcoholic liquors from molasses   |
| <b>F.S.</b>              | <b>Fermentable Sugar</b> means sugar content present in molasses which can be converted into alcohol   |
| <b>FHB</b>               | <b>Financial Hand Book</b>   |
| <b>G-6</b>               | Register maintained by the excise offices having all the receipts of the excise department   |
| <b>Grade of Molasses</b> | Categories of molasses in reference to percentage of sugar content present in molasses   |
| <b>IML</b>               | <b>Indian Made Liquor</b>  |
| <b>IMFL</b>              | <b>Indian Made Foreign Liquor</b> means spirit made in India and sophisticated or coloured so as to resemble flavour or colour of liquor imported into India           |

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| <b>Model Shop</b> | Shops having facility of drinking of IMFL and Beer   |
| <b>Molasses</b>   | Molasses is crystallised syrup obtained as an important by product in the process of manufacture of sugar  |
| <b>MGQ</b>        | <b>Minimum Guaranteed Quota</b>  |
| <b>PD</b>         | <b>Production and Distillation</b>   |
| <b>Spirit</b>     | Means any liquor containing alcohol obtained by distillation whether it is denatured or not                |
| <b>TRS</b>        | <b>Total Reducing Sugar</b> means percentage of total sugar content present in molasses                    |
| <b>UFS</b>        | <b>Un Fermentable Sugar</b> means sugar content present in molasses which cannot be converted into alcohol |
| <b>V/V</b>        | <b>Volume by Volume</b>  |
| <b>Wash</b>       | means a saccharine solution from which spirit is obtained from distillation                                |
