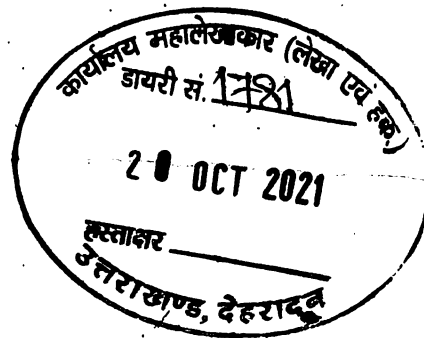

No. No. 990-Edn (CS) dated 24/09/2021 has sanctioned revised rates of medical relief @Rs.500/- p.m, to all pre as well as post-01/01/2016 pensioners/family pensioners in respect of Teaching staff including Graduate Laboratory Instructors/Instructresses, Librarians/Asstt. Librarian, Physical Instructors/Instructresses and equivalent category and non-teaching staff of State aided Non-Government Colleges erstwhile Sponsored Colleges with effect from 01/01/2020 .

All concerned Pension Disbursing Authorities are requested to make necessary arrangement for immediate payment of revised rates of medical relief to the above mentioned pensioners/family pensioners after proper adjustment of amount already paid to them.

**Subject : Grant of Dearness Relief to the Bihar Government pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2021.**

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Bihar/Vol.- IX/DR/122 dated 03-12-2019, this is to state that the Government of Bihar in their FD Resolution No. 3A-2-Be.Pu.- (Allowance)-08/2013-5422/B. dated 19-08-2021 has sanctioned dearness relief to their pensioners/family pensioners whose pension have been revised in the light of Bihar Government F D Resolution Nos. B. (27)Pe.Co.-(Re.)22/2017 - 381 dated 23-05-2017 and B. (27)Pe.Co.-(Rev.)22/2017 - 755 dated 20-10-2017 (circulated under Nos. . Pen. Co-ordn./Bihar/Vol.- IX/Revision/63 dated 13-07-2017 and Pen. Co-ordn./Bihar/Vol.- IX/Revision-Detail/191 dated 19-01-2018), at the rate and from the date as under :-

| <i>Date of effect</i> | <i>Rate of Dearness Relief per month</i> |
|-----------------------|------------------------------------------|
| 01-07-2021            | 28% of basic pension/family pension      |

2. Payment of dearness relief involving fraction of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and fraction less than 50 paise may be ignored.

3. Dearness relief will be admissible to the civil pensioners who are getting compensatory pension, old age pension, retiring pension and invalid pension. This relief is also admissible to the pensioners getting provisional pension/family pension and extra ordinary pension.

4. Dearness relief will not be admissible at present to the re-employed pensioners. The matter will be communicated on receipt of reply from the Accountant General (A&E), Bihar.

5. So far as application of this order in respect of the retired employees of the High Court/Bihar Legislative Assembly/Bihar Legislative Council is concerned, necessary orders will be issued separately by the respective secretariat/office after obtaining the concurrence of the Chief Justice, Patna High Court/Speaker, Bihar Legislative Assembly/Chairman, Bihar Legislative Council, Bihar, Patna.

6. Incidentally, it may be mentioned that this circular is issued to other Accountants General just to remind them the applicability of this order to the West Bengal Government pensioners/family pensioners guided by Bihar Pension Rules.

7. Having been authorised by the Accountant General (A&E), Bihar in their letter No. Pen-545 dated 06-09-2021, it is requested to make necessary arrangements for payment of dearness relief @ 28% with effect from 01-07-2021 to all eligible Bihar Government pensioners/family pensioners as well as West Bengal Government pensioners/family pensioners guided by Bihar Pension Rules on their revised pension/family pension mentioned above after proper adjustment. Arrear of dearness relies for the month of August 2021 will be paid with the pension/family pension of November 2021.

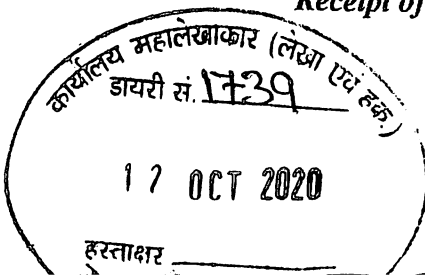
