ORDER:

In the reference 1st read above, Government have issued orders with clear guidelines for sanction of consolidated pension to the University/ Government Degree Colleges and Aided teaching staff working in Private Aided Degree College teachers who drew UGC scales of pay and retired from service prior to 01.01.2016. The implementation of the consolidation of UGC Pensions are still is under process for want various clarifications.

2. In the references 2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th read above while issuing Dearness Allowance to the employees working in State Government in respect of UGC employees, the following are clarified:

“Government also hereby order that the Dearness Allowance to State Government employees who will draw the Revised U.G.C. Pay Scales, 2016 shall be admissible at the rate of 2%, 4%, 5% and 7% respectively, of the basic pay from time to time (after implementation of the Revised U.G.C. Pay Scales, 2016)”.

3. In the references 3rd, 5th, 7th and 9th read above, Government while issuing Dearness Relief to the pensioners and family pensioners of University/Government Degree Colleges and Aided teaching staff of Private Aided Degree Colleges who will draw the Revised U.G.C. Pay Scales, 2016, the same was not incorporated, as the consolidation of the UGC pay scales to the retirees are under process.

4. Government after careful consideration hereby order to release the Dearness Relief to the pensioners and family pensioners of University/Government Degree Colleges and Aided teaching staff of Private Aided Degree Colleges who will draw the Revised U.G.C. Pay Scales, 2016 as detailed in the following table on par with employees who will draw the Revised U.G.C. Pay Scales, 2016.

The payment of revised Dearness Relief rates as per the U.G.C. circulars from time to time for the period from 01.01.2016 to 30.06.2018 on revised consolidated pension is applicable as and when orders for arrears of pension sanctioned issued, as detailed at para 16 of the G.O. 1st read above.

5. These orders are not applicable to the financial assistance grantees and others who are not entitled to Dearness Relief.

6. All the Treasury Officers/ Pension Payment Officers shall work out and make payments of the Dearness Relief on Pension sanctioned in this order without waiting for further authorization/ instructions from the Accountant General (A&E), Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad, in terms of the orders issued in the G.O.Ms.No.270, Finance & Planning (FW: PSC.I) Department, dated 7.10.1986.

7. All the Treasury Officers/Pension Payment Officers shall work out and make payments of the dearness relief on pension sanctioned in this order in terms of orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.122, Finance (Pen.I) Department, Dt: 22.05.2014

8. The expenditure is allocable among the various States in accordance with provisions of Rule 24 of the incidence of pension rules in Appendix III-B of the Andhra Pradesh Accounts Code, Volume-I.

9. In respect of the categories of employees who are not covered for payment through the Treasuries, the expenditure shall be debited to the Pension Funds of Zilla Parishads and Pension funds of the respective Municipal Councils.

10. In respect of the Pensioners of the Universities the expenditure on account of the Dearness Relief now sanctioned above shall be met from the Block Grants allotted to them.
