Subject: Grant of dearness relief to State Government's civil/family pensioners.

Vide government order No. 24/2021-G-3-804/X-2021-301/2000T.C. Dated 22 December, 2021 the dearness relief admissible to pensioners/ family pensioners of the state was increased from 28 percent to 31 percent w.e.f. July 01, 2021.

2- The undersigned is directed to say that the Governor is pleased to grant one more installment of dearness relief of 03 percent w.e.f. January 01, 2022 on the pension/ family pension revised/ determined under the provisions of the government orders issued under the recommendations of Uttar Pradesh pay Committee 2016.

3- As a consequence of the above-mentioned 03 percent rise, the dearness relief payable on the pension/family pension will rise from existing 31 percent to 34 percent with effect from January 01, 2022.

4- In the calculation of dearness relief, fraction of a rupee less than its half shall be ignored while half or more shall be counted as one rupee.

5- These orders will not be applicable to the Judges of High Court, employees of local bodies and public undertakings /corporations etc in respect of whom separate orders will be issued by respective departments. Orders in respect of All India Service pensioners/family pensioners are being issued.

6- These orders will also be applicable to the pensioners of the institutions aided from State Fund, under the Education/ Technical Education Departments,

whose pension / family pension is at par with that of the pensioners of the State Government.

7- As per orders issued in O.M. No. A-1-252 /X-10(3)-81 dated April 27, 1982 the Accountant General's authority is not necessary for payment of relief of pension and as such the payment of dearness relief shall be made by the concerned pension disbursing authorities on the basis of this office memorandum alone.

8- Other terms and conditions regarding grant of dearness relief laid down in earlier Government orders shall remain applicable as before.
