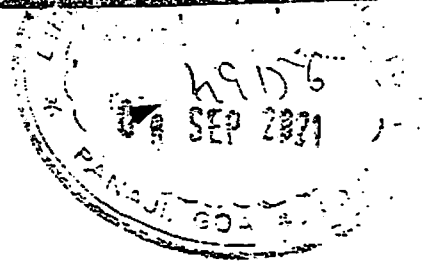
1. Kindly refer the circular No. 3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV 7th September 2021 and Circular No. 3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV 17th November 2021 issued from the office of the Government of Goa. Finance (Expenditure) Department Secretariat, Porvorim - Goa, has conveyed the sanction for revision of Dearness allowance to the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission.

Now as per para 3 of the said circulars dated 07/09/2021 and 17/11/2021 Government of Goa has decided to 'EXTEND' the Office Memoranda of Dearness Allowance which is issued by Finance (Expenditure) Department from time to time for the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission for grant of Dearness Relief to pensioners of the Autonomous bodies / Corporations who are in pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission, under their administrative control, in order to resolve the hardship faced by the pensioner of Autonomous bodies / Corporations. The copy of the said circular dated 07/09/2021 and 17/11/2021 are enclosed for information and necessary action.
2. Since the order on relief contained in the above Finance (Expenditure) Department are applicable to the employees / pensioners and Family Pensioners of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances and pension & Pensionery benefits in the pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission and drawing Dearness Relief at the rate of 164%, I am to authorize you to pay Pensioners / Family Pensioners of State Government and its Autonomous bodies / Corporation the revised rates of Dearness Relief which has been enhanced from i.e. 164% to 189% w.e.f. 01/07/2021 vide order no. 3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV dated 7th September 2021 and further the above Dearness Relief is enhanced from 189% to 196% w.e.f. 01/07/2021 vide order no. 3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV dated 17th November 2021. The Dearness Relief may therefore be directly revised from 164% to 196% w.e.f. 01/07/2021 and the arrears accrued till date may be released to the above Pensioners.
3. In case of Goa State Government Pensioners drawing pension in other States, the instruction contained in above Office Memorandum may be issued to all the Treasuries / Sub Treasuries / P.A.O where they are drawing their monthly pension.

4. This Dearness relief is not applicable to the following class of Pensioners.
 - a. Pensioners drawing pension, which is granted after Independence for Political consideration (Ex-Rulers).
 - b. Retired High Court and Supreme Court Judges for whom order will be issued separately by administrative authorities concerned.
 - c. Pensioners of other states (PAO) Suspense) for whom separate orders are applicable.
 - d. M.L.A. Pensioners.
 - e. Freedom Fighters of Govt. of Goa.


Subject: Revised rates of Dearness Allowance to the employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission w.e.f. 01.07.2021

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No. 13(1)/2008-F (B) dated 2nd October, 2019 revising the rate of Dearness Allowance (DA) w.e.f. 01.07.2019 in respect of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission and to this Department's O.M. No. 13(1)/2020-F (B) dated 23.04.2020 vide which instalments of Dearness Allowance to Central Government employees due from 01.01.2020, 01.07.2020 and 01.01.2021 were frozen.

2. The rate of DA admissible to above categories of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies shall be enhanced from the existing 184% to 189% of the Basic Pay with effect from 01.07.2021. The increase subsumes the additional instalments arising on 01.01.2020, 01.07.2020 and 01.01.2021. The rate of Dearness Allowance for the period from 01.01.2020 to 30.06.2021 shall remain at 184%.

3. The provisions contained in paras 3, 4 and 5 of this Ministry's O.M.No.13(1)/2008-F (B) dated 20th August, 2008 shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.


1. The Government of Goa, Finance (Rev. & Cont.) Department Secretariat, Porvorim, vide letter No. 12/3/82-Fin(R &C)/Vol.1/278 29th April 2022 have conveyed the sanction for revision of Dearness Relief to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of Goa Government as contained in Office Memorandum No. 42/07/2022-P&PW(D) dated 05th April 2022 issued by Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Pension, & Pensioner's Welfare, New Delhi. The copy of the said Office Memorandum is enclosed for information and necessary action.

2. Since the order on relief contained in the above Government of India's Office Memorandum is adopted and made applicable to the Goa Government Pensioners and Family Pensioners, I am to authorize you to pay to the Goa Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners enhanced Dearness Relief @ 34% from existing 31% with effect from 01/01/2022.
The Dearness Relief @ 34% is to be paid to the Pensioners w.e.f. 01/01/2022 and is to be released alongwith the arrears from 01/01/2022 to 30/04/2022, in the monthly pension payable from month of May, 2022. It is also applicable to the following pensioners.
 - (a). Ex-gratia pensioners (Montepio pensioners, pensioners drawing pensions on account of service rendered to Portuguese colonies and institute Ultramarine Pensioners) drawing pensions under C/B/D and E series.
 - (b). Pensao de Sanguic pensioners.
 - (c). Pensioners receiving pension under triple benefit scheme.
 - (d). Recipients of Ex-gratia i.e. Families of deceases pensioners/employees who were governed under E.F.U.
 - (e). Pensioners sanctioned pension under Education Act 15 of 1985 and drawing pension under pension payment series T and E.B.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners - Revised rate effective from 01.01.2022.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No.42/7/2021-P&PW (D) dated 27.10.2021 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief admissible to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 31 % to 34% w.c.f. 01.01.2022.

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2. These rates of DR will be applicable to the following categories:-
- i. Civilian Central Government Pensioners/ Family Pensioners including Central Govt. absorbee pensioners in PSU/Autonomous Bodies in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 4/34/2002-P&PW(D)Vol.II dated 23.06.2017 for restoration of full pension after expiry of commutation period of 15 years.
 - ii. The Armed Forces Pensioners. Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates,
 - iii. All India Service Pensioners
 - iv. Railway Pensioners/family pensioners
 - v. Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension
 - vi. The Burma Civilian pensioners/ family pensioners and pensioners/ families of displaced Government pensioners from Burma/Pakistan, in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's O.M. No.23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 11.09.2017.
3. The payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
4. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's O.M. No.45/73/97-P&PW(G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended from time to time. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.
5. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.
6. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.
7. The offices of Accountant General and authorised Pension Disbursing Banks are requested to arrange payment of relief to pensioners etc. on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No.528-TA.II/34-80-II dated 23/04/1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No.GANB No.2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.
8. In so far as the persons serving in Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, as mandated under Article 148 (5) of the Constitution of India.
9. This issues in accordance with the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure s O.M. No.1/2/2022-E.II(B) dated 31.03.2022.
