ORDER:

The Government of India, Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Justice has appointed the Second National Judicial Pay Commission in pursuance of the directions of the Honble Supreme-Court of India, vide Resolution 4th read above to examine and make suitable recommendations relating to the pay structure and emoluments of Judicial Officers in the States and Union Territories, including pension and other post-retirement benefits and also to examine the work methods and work environment with a view to promoting efficiency in judicial administration. The said Commission submitted its report on interim relief on 09.03.2018 and the Honble Supreme Court by order dated 27.03.2018 directed all the States to implement the recommendations of the Commission with regard to interim relief. Accordingly, Government of Andhra Pradesh sanctioned 30% interim relief to all the Judicial Officers, Pensioners vide reference 6th read above.

2. The Second National Judicial Pay Commission has submitted its report with regard to the pay, pension and allowances of the Judicial Officers to Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in their orders, dated 27.07.2022 in W.P.(C) No.643 of 2015 directed all the States/UTs to implement the revision of pay structure of Judicial Officers as recommended by SNJPC with effect from 01.01.2016.

3. The Government in pursuance of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, dated 27.07.2022 and in obedience thereof hereby order to implement the revised pay scales to the Judicial Officers w.e.f.01.01.2016 as recommended by Second National Judicial Pay Commission as follows:

d. Fixation of pay in the pay matrix in regard to migration/fitment of the serving judicial officers on 01.01.2016 as indicated in Table-II above is broadly based on the following points:

- i. Multiply the existing pay by the factor of 2.81
- in The figure so arrived at to be located in Table-I, in relation to the Level applicable to the Officer (i.e., J1, J2 etc.)
- iii. Where there is an identical figure available in Table-I at the corresponding stage of the relevant level, the new revised pay shall be fixed at that stage.
- iv. Where there is no identical figure available, the new revised pay has to be fixed at the very next higher stage in that level in Table-I.

e. Fixation of pay on promotion on or after 01.01.2016:

For those who are promoted from the previous level to the next level, or granted financial upgradation/ACP or Selection Grade or Super Time Scale, the procedure for fixing the pay in the new pay matrix on such promotion/financial upgradation, will be as follows:

- i. Identify the level and the basic pay in Table-I on the date of promotion.
- ii. Add one increment in that level itself in terms of FR-22.
- ii. The figure so arrived at or the next closest figure in the level to which s(he) is promoted will be the new pay on promotion.

f. Increment:

The annual increment shall be @ 3% cumulative, meaning thereby that the increment @ 3% has to be calculated on the previous years basic pay instead of fixed amount increments recommended by FNJPC and JPC.

g. Dearness Allowance & other Allowances

Dearness Allowance shall be as admissible at the rates applicable to the Central Government employees drawing VII CPC Pay Scales. As regards the other allowances, the amounts presently being drawn shall continue to be drawn, pending further orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in that regard and subject to final adjustment.

h. Payment of Arrears:

The arrears shall be computed with effect from 01.01.2016 and after adjusting the interim relief already paid, the balance amount shall be paid in stages in the following manner, subject to production of an undertaking in the Form appended to this order:

i	25% in cash within a period of 3 months from 27.07.2022 i.e. from the date of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court;					
11	Another 25% to be paid in cash within 3 months thereafter; and					
iii	The balance 50% has to be paid on or before the end of June, 2023.					

4. The Registrar General, High Court of Andhra Pradesh shall take necessary further action in the matter, accordingly.

ORDER:

In the reference 1st read above, Government have issued comprehensive orders, for Revision of Pay Scales, 2022 to the retired employees (Pensioners/Family pensioners) of Government of Andhra Pradesh.

2. In the reference 2nd read above, Government have issued orders for release of Dearness Relief (DR) for the period from 01.07.2019 to 31.12.2021 to the pensioners/family pensioners including Judicial pensioners/ Family pensioners.

3. In the reference 3rd read above, Government have issued orders for release of Dearness Relief (DR) in respect of Pensioners /Family Pensioners, drawing their pay in the Revised UGC Pay Scales, 2006 and the Judicial Pensioners/Family Pensioners whose pay was revised as per Sri Padmanabhan Committee Report vide the G.O. Ms. No.73, Law (LA&J, SCF) Department, dated 01.05.2010 with effect from 01.07.2021.

4. In the reference 4th and 5th read above, Government have issued orders for release of Dearness Relief (DR) with effect from 01.01.2022 & 01-07-2022 in respect of Pensioners /Family Pensioners including Judicial pensioners/Family pensioners.

5. Government hereby order the revision of rates of Dearness Relief in respect of Judicial Officers whose pay scales were revised as per Second National Judicial Pay Commission, vide G.O.Ms.No.58, Law(LA&J SC-F) Department, dated 22.10.2022, from 38% to 42% of the Basic Pay with effect from 01.01.2023.

6. Government also hereby order the revision of rates of Dearness Relief in respect of Judicial pensioners whose pay scales were revised as per Shri Padmanabhan Committee Report, vide G.O.Ms.No.73, Law(LA&J SC-F) Department, dated 01.05.2010 from 212% to 221% of the Basic Pay with effect from 01.01.2023.

7. The Dearness Relief sanctioned in the above paras, shall be paid with pension of December, 2023 payable in January,2024. The arrears on account of increase of Dearness Relief for the period from 01.01.2023 to 30.11.2023 shall bepaid in the month of January, 2024.

8. All the Treasury Officers/ Pension Payment Officers shall work out and make payments of the Dearness Relief on Pension sanctioned in this order without waiting for further authorization/ instructions from the Accountant General (A&E),Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada in terms of the orders issued in the G.O.Ms.No.270, Finance & Planning (FW: PSC.1)⁻ Department, dated. 7.10.1986.

9. All the Treasury Officers/Pension Payment Officers shall work out and make payments of the dearness relief on pension sanctioned in this order in terms of orders issued in the G.O.Ms.No.122, Finance (Pen.I) Department, Dt: 22.05.2014.

10. The expenditure is allocable among the various States in accordance with provisions of Rule 24 of the incidence of Pension Rules in Appendix III-B of the Andhra Pradesh Accounts Code, Volume-I.

 The CEO, APCFSS is directed to develop a software module to calculate --the DA arrears and generate due drawn statement to facilitate generation of DA arrears bills by the Drawing & Disbursing Officers.

Kind attention is invited in the reference cited.

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2. It is informed that certain retired employees have filed various cases in the Hon'ble High Court, AP, seeking a direction to stop further recovery of commutation portion of pension from their original basic pension and to refund the excess amounts already recovered, as the entire commutation amount along with interest has been recovered before the stipulated 15-year period against Rule 18 of the Andhra Pradesh Civil Pensions (Commutation) Rules, 1944.

3. In this regard, vide reference 1st cited, the Learned Additional Advocate General has requested to file the counter Affidavit in cases mentioned in the reference 2nd cited and other connected Writ Petitions at the earliest preferably before the date fixed by the Hon'ble Division Bench i.e., on or before 29.11.2024. The Learned AAG BEZBESO/ZOZ4/D SEC-DTA

advised to instruct the concerned not to deduct the commutation amount from those pensioners who have completed 11 years 3 months from the date of sanction of commutation until the final orders of the Hon ble Court, in view of the various cases that are being filed daily by the retired pensioners.

4. In view of the above circumstances, the Director of Treasuries & Accounts is hereby instructed **not to deduct the commutation portion of pension** from all the pensioners who have completed 11 years 3 months, till further orders.
