Sub: Grant of Dearness relief to the retired All India Services Pensioners and Retired State Judicial Officers -effective from 01.07.2021 reg:

- Ref: 1) OMNo42/07/2021-P&PW(D) dt 22.07.2021
- 2) OM No 1/3(1)2008-EII(B) dt 13.08.2021
- 3) GO(P)No.55/2011/Home. Dated 24.02.2011

As per OM cited (1) above Dearness relief payable to Central Government Pensioners/family pensioners was enhanced from 17% to 28% and by (2) above those continued to draw their pay/pension in 6<sup>th</sup> CPC rates from 164% to 189% from 01.07.2021. The instalments of Dearness Relief/ from 01.01.2020 to 01.01.2021 stands frozen vide Ministry of finance (Dept of Expenditure) OM No 1/1/2020-E-II(B) dt 23.04.2020, are not payable.

Government of Kerala as per orders cited (3) above had extended the benefit of increase in Dearness Relief sanctioned to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners coming under the category of State Judicial Officers without further orders from Government. Hence you are requested to honour the claim for enhanced Dearness Relief at the rate of 28% to Central Government Pensioners/family pensioners and 189% to retired State Judicial Officers with effect from 01.07.2021.

Revised DR at Central Rates will not be admissible to other categories of State pensioners/family pensioners viz. UGC/AICTE/Medical ED etc. till said rates are released by State Government.

The Dearness relief payable to retired State Judicial Officers who are drawing Dearness relief at central rates and whose pension/family pension has not been revised as per G.O. (MS.) No. 236/10/Home dt. 2-11-2010 and Pensioners and Family pensioners including those coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes retired after 1-7-2004 whose pension has undergone revision as per G.O. (P) 84/2007/Fin. dated 1-3-2007 and has not undergone revision as per G.O. (P) 211/2011/Fin dated 7-5-2011 are eligible for Dearness Relief at the rate specified in Para (xv) of the Government Order.

The Dearness relief payable to Ex-Chairman and Members of Kerala and the teaching staff coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes retired after 1-1-2006 who have changed over to revised scale of pay and retired State Judicial Officers whose pension has been revised as per G.O. (Ms.) No. 236/10/Home dated 2-11-2010, the rate of DR will be as specified in para (xv) and (xvi) of Government Order.

The DR payable to State Pensioners/Family Pensioners whose pension has not undergone revision as per G.O. (P) No. 180/2006/Fin. dated 18-4-2006 and Pensioners and Family pensioners including those coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes whose pension has undergone revision as per G.O. (P) 81/2007/Fin. dated 28-2-2007 or G.O. (P) 84/2007/Fin. dated 1-3-2007 will be at the rates specified in para (xvii) of the order.

**Sub.** Dearness Relief on pension with effect from 1-1-2019 to 1-7-2020 (Four Installments) to State Service Pensioners and Family Pensioners and 1-1-2019 & 1-7-2019 to pensioners coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes and those drawing DR at Central rates.

While endorsing a copy of G. O. (P) No. 25/2021/Fin. dated 9-2-2021, I am to authorize you to pay the revised rates of Dearness Relief with effect from 1-1-2019, 1-7-2019, 1-1-2020 and 1-7-2020 to Kerala State Service Pensioners and Family Pensioners. The revised Dearness Relief due from 1-1-2019 @3%, 1-7-2019 @3%, 1-1-2020 @4% and 1-7-2020 @4% respectively. The arrears of Dearness Relief shall be paid in cash in four installments made on April 2021, June 2021, September 2021 and December 2021. Pensioners those coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes and those drawing Dearness Relief at Central rates included retired State Judicial Officers are eligible for the installments declared from 1-1-2019 and 1-7-2019 only. The frozen Dearness Relief of all pensioners who are drawing Dearness Relief at Central rates will be granted on restoration of the same by Government of India.

Pensioners/Family pensioners, whose pension/family pension has not undergone revision as per G. O. (P) 09/2016/Fin. dated 20-1-2016 and in respect of Pensioners and Family pensioners including those coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes retired prior to 1-7-2004 whose pension/family pension has undergone revision as per G. O. (P) No. 81/2007/Fin. dated 28-2-2007 and has not undergone revision as per G.O.(P) 21/2011/Fin. dated 7-5-2011 are eligible for Dearness Relief at the rate specified in Para (xii) & (xiii) of Government Order.

In the Office Memoranda cited above, Government of India sanctioned revised rate of Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief to Central Government Employees, Pensioners and Family Pensioners with effect from 1-1-2019, 1-7-2019, 1-1-2020 and 1-7-2020. On the basis of the above, the following orders are issued:

- 2. (i) The rate of Dearness Allowance payable in respect of State Government Employees, Teachers, Staff of Aided Schools, Private Colleges and Polytechnics, Full Time Employees home on the contingent and work charged establishments and employees of Local Bodies will be enhanced from the existing rate of 20% to 23% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 28% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 32% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 36% w.e.f. 1-7-2020.

(ii) The Dearness Allowance payable in respect of those employees continuing in the pre-revised scale of G.O. (P) No. 85/2011/Fin. dated 26-2-2011 will be enhanced from the existing rate of 121% to 127% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 137% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 147% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 155% w.e.f. 1-7-2020.

(iii) The Dearness Allowance payable in respect of those employees continuing in the pre-revised scale of G.O. (P) No. 145/2006/Fin. dated 25-3-2006 will be enhanced from the existing rate of 275% to 286% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 303% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 320% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 334% w.e.f. 1-7-2020.

(iv) The Dearness Allowance payable in respect of teachers coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes (in whose case DA up to 50% has been converted as Dearness Pay) will be enhanced from the existing rate of 284% to 295% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 312% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 329% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 343% w.e.f. 1-7-2020

(v) The Dearness Allowance payable in respect of the teaching staff coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have changed over to revised UGC/AICTE scale from 1-1-2006 or thereafter and Judicial Officers will be enhanced from the existing rate of 148% to 154% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 164% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 174% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 182% w.e.f. 1-7-2020.

(vi) The DA payable in respect of teaching staff coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have changed over to revised UGC/AICTE scale from 1-1-2016 or thereafter will be 2% w.e.f. 1-7-2016, 4% w.e.f. 1-1-2017, 5% w.e.f. 1-7-2017, 7% w.e.f. 1-1-2018, 9% w.e.f. 1-7-2018, 12% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 17% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 21% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 25% w.e.f. 1-7-2020. The Dearness Allowance payable to those employees who are continuing in the 1997 pay scales given after 1-1-2019 will be enhanced from the existing rate of 334% to 345% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 362% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 379% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 393% w.e.f. 1-7-2020 (up to the date of effect of option under Pay Revision 2014). The frozen Dearness Relief of all Pensioners, who are drawing Dearness Relief at Central rates, will be granted on restoration of the same by Government of India only.

(vii) The Dearness Allowance payable to those employees in the Sector Undertakings who were getting pay and allowances based on scales of pay admissible under 992 Pay Revision will be enhanced as follows with effect from 1-1-2019, 1-7-2019, 1-1-2020 and 1-7-2020.

(viii) The Dearness Allowance at the enhanced rate will be paid in cash along with the salary for the month of March 2021 onwards and arrears up to February, 2021 will be merged in the PF Account.

(ix) The enhanced rate of Dearness Allowance will also be applicable to Part-time and Part-time contingent employees on the basis of pay drawn by them.

(x) (a) The Dearness Relief payable to State Service Pensioners, Family Pensioners, Ex-gratia Pensioners/Ex-gratia Family pensioners whose Pension/Family Pension has been revised as per G. O. (P) No. 09/2016/Fin. dated 20-1-2016 will be enhanced from the existing rate of 20% to 25% with effect from 1-1-2019, 28% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 32% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 36% w.e.f. 1-7-2020.

(b) The Dearness Relief payable to UGC Pensioners/Family Pensioners [whose Pension/Family Pension has been revised as per G. O. (P) No. 151/2020/Fin. dated 5-11-2020] will be enhanced from the existing rate of 9% to 12% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 17% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 21% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 25% w.e.f. 1-7-2020.

(c) The Dearness Relief payable to UGC Pensioners/Family Pensioners whose Pension/Family Pension has not been undergone revision as per G. O. (P) No. 151/2020/Fin. dated 5-11-2020 will be enhanced from the existing rate of 148% to 154% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 163% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 174% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 182% w.e.f. 1-7-2020.

(xi) Re-employed pensioners whose pay has been revised as per G. O. (P) No. 2/17/Fin. dated 4-1-2017 are eligible for payment of Dearness Allowance at the enhanced rate of 25% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 28% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 32% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 36% w.e.f. 1-7-2020 as admissible to State Government Employees and they are eligible for this enhanced rate of Dearness Allowance based on a general letter of authority issued by the Accountant General.

(xii) The Dearness Relief payable to State Service Pensioners and Family Pensioners [whose Pension/Family Pension has not undergone revision as per G. O. (P) No. 09/2016/Fin. dated 20-1-2016] will be enhanced from the existing rate of 121% to 127% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 137% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 147% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and 155% w.e.f. 1-7-2020.

(vi) The rate of Dearness Relief payable to the teaching staff earning under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have changed over to revised UGC/AICTE scale from 1-1-2006 and those who retired after 1-1-2006 and that to the State Judicial Officers whose pension has been revised as per G.O. (Ms.) No. 236/2010/Home dated 2-11-2010, will be enhanced from the existing rate of 148% to 154% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 164% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 174% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and to 182% w.e.f. 1-7-2020. This rate will be adopted only after the formal sanctioning of revision of their pension in terms of G.O. (P) No. 211/2011/Fin. dated 7-5-2011. The teaching staff coming under the UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have retired prior to 1-1-2006 and whose pension has been revised in terms of G.O. (P) No. 211/2011 Fin. dated 7-5-2011 will also be eligible for Dearness Relief at the above rate.

(vii) The rate of Dearness Relief payable to the teaching staff earning under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have changed over to revised UGC/AICTE scale from 1-1-2006 and those who retired after 1-1-2006 and that to the State Judicial Officers whose pension has been revised as per G.O. (Ms.) No. 236/2010/Home dated 2-11-2010, will be enhanced from the existing rate of 148% to 154% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 164% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 174% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and to 182% w.e.f. 1-7-2020. This rate will be adopted only after the formal sanctioning of revision of their pension in terms of G.O. (P) No. 211/2011/Fin. dated 7-5-2011. The teaching staff coming under the UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have retired prior to 1-1-2006 and whose pension has been revised in terms of G.O. (P) No. 211/2011 Fin. dated 7-5-2011 will be eligible for Dearness Relief at the above rate.

(viii) The Dearness Relief payable in respect of the State Service Pensioners/Family Pensioners whose pension has not undergone revision as per G.O. (P) No. 180/2006 Fin. dated 18-4-2006 and who are drawing Pension/Family Pension as per Pension Revision 1997 and in respect of Pensioners/Family Pensioners coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes whose pension has not undergone revision as per G.O. (P) No. 81/2007/Fin. dated 28-2-2007 or G.O. (P) No. 84/2007/Fin. dated 1-3-2007 will be enhanced from the existing rate of 334% to 345% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 362% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 379% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and to 393% w.e.f. 1-7-2020. This will be applicable only till such date of effect of option for Pension Revision 2004, after which the Dearness Relief payable will be as indicated in para 2 (xiii) above and after the date of effect of option for Pension Revision 2009, Dearness Relief will be payable as indicated in para 2 (xii) above.

(ix) The rate of Dearness Relief payable to the teaching staff earning under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have changed over to revised UGC/AICTE scale from 1-1-2006 and those who retired after 1-1-2006 and that to the State Judicial Officers whose pension has been revised as per G.O. (Ms.) No. 236/2010/Home dated 2-11-2010, will be enhanced from the existing rate of 148% to 154% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 164% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 174% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and to 182% w.e.f. 1-7-2020. This rate will be adopted only after the formal sanctioning of revision of their pension in terms of G.O. (P) No. 211/2011/Fin. dated 7-5-2011. The teaching staff coming under the UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes who have retired prior to 1-1-2006 and whose pension has been revised in terms of G.O. (P) No. 211/2011 Fin. dated 7-5-2011 will also be eligible for Dearness Relief at the above rate.

(x) The Dearness Relief payable in respect of the State Service Pensioners/Family Pensioners whose pension has not undergone revision as per G.O. (P) No. 180/2006 Fin. dated 18-4-2006 and who are drawing Pension/Family Pension as per Pension Revision 1997 and in respect of Pensioners/Family Pensioners coming under UGC/AICTE/Medical Education Schemes whose pension has not undergone revision as per G.O. (P) No. 81/2007/Fin. dated 28-2-2007 or G.O. (P) No. 84/2007/Fin. dated 1-3-2007 will be enhanced from the existing rate of 334% to 345% w.e.f. 1-1-2019, 362% w.e.f. 1-7-2019, 379% w.e.f. 1-1-2020 and to 393% w.e.f. 1-7-2020. This will be applicable only till such date of effect of option for Pension Revision 2004, after which the Dearness Relief payable will be as indicated in para 2 (xiii) above and after the date of effect of option for Pension Revision 2009, Dearness Relief will be payable as indicated in para 2 (xii) above.

3. The revised rate of Dearness Allowance due from 1-1-2019 to 1-7-2020 may be paid in cash along with the salary of March 2021 onwards and the arrears up to February 2021 will be merged to PF Account. Withdrawal of arrears of DA credited into the PF Account for



the installments due from 1-1-2019 (3%), 1-7-2019 (5%), 1-1-2020 (4%) and 1-7-2020 (4%) shall be made only after 1-4-2023, 1-9-2023, 1-4-2024 and 1-9-2024 respectively or after retirement whichever is earlier. The frozen Dearness Allowance of all employees, who are drawing Dearness Allowance at Central rates, will be granted on restoration of the same by Government of India only.

4. The revised Dearness Relief due from 1-1-2019 to 1-7-2020 may be paid along with the Pension of April 2021 onwards. The arrears of the Dearness Relief shall be paid in cash in four equal installments made on April 2021, June 2021, September 2021 and December 2021.

5. The conditions laid down in the Government Order read as 7th paper above shall be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance/ Dearness Relief under these orders.

6. The C. O. read 15th paper above stands cancelled.
