PENSIONS - Sanction of Consolidated Pension to the Pensioners retired prior to 01-01-1993 - Orders - Issued.

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ORDER :

Preamble Orders have been issued in the G.O. third read above merging the existing D.A. as on 01-07-1992 with basic pay in respect of State Government employees with effect from 01-01-1993, with monetary effect from 01-04-1993.

Preamble Orders have been issued in the G.O. third read above merging the existing D.A. as on 01-07-1992 with basic pay in respect of State Government employees with effect from 01-01-1993, with monetary effect from 01-04-1993.

2. Pensioners in the State are also drawing the percentage of Dearness Relief on their basic pension at the rates last sanctioned in the G.O. second read above with effect from 01-07-1992. Government have examined the desirability of sanctioning the consolidation of pension and accordingly the following orders are issued:

Consolidation of Pension

3.1. The existing pension/family pension/compassionate pension/compassionate allowance in respect of those who retired or died while in service before 01-01-1993, and also those who retired or died while in service on or after 01-01-1993, but who had opted for the pre-revised scales, i.e. 1986 scales, and the relief on pension sanctioned in the G.O. second read above with effect from 01-07-1992 shall be merged and will be known as Consolidated Pension. This Consolidated Pension shall come into force with effect from 01-01-1993.

3.2. The Consolidated Pension ordered in para 3.1 shall be rounded off to the next rupee.

Applicability 3.3 The consolidation of pension as ordered now, shall apply to:

(a) categories of pensioners referred to in para 4 of G.O.(P)No.78, Finance dt.18-03-80.

(b) Jagir and Estate pensioners and

(c) to pensioner governed by Revised Pension Rules, 1980

(i) who retired or died prior to 01-01-1993 and

(ii) also those who retired or died on or after 01-01-1993 but without the benefit of Revised Pay Scales, 1993.

Non-Applicability 3.4 The above consolidation of pension does not apply to:

(i) To those who have been drawing pay in the revised Pay Scales, 1993/Revised U.G.C. Scales of 1986(including those who are governed by the Revised pay scales of 1993/Revised U.G.C. Scales of 1986) even if, because of administrative reasons, they have not actually drawn the pay in the Revised Pay Scales as yet).

(ii) those who are governed by orders issued in G.O.(P).No.238, Fin. & Plg. (Fin.Wing Pen.I) Department, dated 04-06-1993.

(iii) Financial Assistance Grantees are not getting D.A. and as such these orders are also not applicable to them.

3.5 Consolidated pension now sanctioned will be worked out with reference to the uncommuted pension. As such, commuted portion of pension should be deducted from the consolidated pension while making monthly disbursements.

3.6 At the time of noting consolidated pension on the Pension Payment Order, the Pension Disbursing Officer shall simultaneously calculate and note the corresponding consolidated enhanced family pension and consolidated normal family pension on the P.P.Os. Similarly, in cases where enhanced family pension is being drawn, the normal family pension, to be drawn in future, would also be consolidated and noted on the P.P.O.

3.7. In respect of pensioners and family pensioners who are employed, the notional relief on pension as on 01.07.1992, which would have been admissible to them but for their re-employment/employment, shall be merged with basic pension with effect from 01.01.1993. The pay drawn by the re-employed pensioners during the period of re-employment shall also be refixed taking into account the enhanced revised pension. Dearness relief beyond 01.01.1993 will not be admissible to them during the period of re-employment vide G.O.Ms.No.341 Fin & Plg.(Fin.Wing P.S.C.) Dept. dated 14.12.1987.

Restriction on 4. The pensioners are not entitled to commute any portion of

Dispensation of 5. All Pension Disbursing Officers, i.e., all Treasury Officers/
A.G's authori- Pension Payment Officers/Public Sector Banks, are requested
sation to implement these orders without any authorisation from the Accountant General (A & E), A.P., Hyderabad.

6. The expenditure is allocable among the various States in accordance with the provisions of G.O.Ms.No.198 Finance dated 10.07.1969.

7. The expenditure shall be debited to the pension funds of Zilla Parishads in so far as the non-teaching, non-Government pensioners of Panchayati Raj Institutions are concerned and the pension funds of the respective Municipal Councils in so far as the non-teaching, non-Government pensioners of Municipalities are concerned and the relevant Head of Account of Government in so far as the teachers are concerned.
