COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE CONTRACT FOR WATER PURIFIER

Office of the Accountant General (Audit), Assam, Maidamgaon, Beltola Guwahati – 781029 invites bids through GeM (Government e-Marketplace) portal from Firms / Agencies for Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) for its 05 Water Purifiers. The period of contract is for 2 (Two) Years from the GeM contract coming into effect.

A. General Terms & Conditions for comprehensive AMC of Water Purifiers

Bids are invited from the reputed/registered Service Dealers for Comprehensive Maintenance Contract in respect of the following 05 Water Purifiers:-

The GeM bids should be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.5,000.00 (Rupees Five thousand only) in the form of a crossed Demand Draft from any scheduled bank drawn in favour of Pay & Accounts Officer, O/o the AG (A&E), Assam. In the absence of EMC, the tender shall be rejected summarily. Micro & Small Enterprises registered with NSIC for Udyon Aadhaaar Memorandum are exempted from submission of EMD as per Rule 170 of General Financial Rules 2017 subject to submission of valid certificate.

This office reserves all rights to reject any bids including of those bidders who fail to comply with the instructions without assigning any reason whatsoever and does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any specific bids. The decision of this office in this regard shall be final and binding.

The contract may be terminated if it is found that the bidder to whom the work has been awarded is blacklisted on previous occasions by any of the Government Departments / Institutions / Local Bodies/Municipalities / Public Sector Undertaking etc.

The Contractor shall completely indemnify and hold harmless the Clint and its employees against any liability, claims, losses or damages sustained by it or them by reason of any breach of contract, wrongful act or negligence by the Contractor or any of its employees engaged in the provision of providing the required services.

Contractors shall positively observe all safety measures required to be undertaken for safety of persons, labours, public and properties at work site.

This office shall be entitled to deduct in accordance with Applicable Laws, Income Tax GST or withholding tax or other deductions (as the case may be), from any payments made to the contractor. The successful bidder shall be required to deposit 5% of contract amount as performance Security within 7 days of award of the contract. The validity of performance security should be 60 days beyond the contract period of 31-12-2022.

B. Scope of Work:

1. **Duration of Contract:** The contract shall remain valid for a period of **two years** from the date of execution. It may be **extended annually** based on **performance appraisal**, **feedback and mutual consent**, **subject the same or revised terms**.

2. Service Frequency & Schedule:

- (a) A minimum of 24 service visits (once in every month) is mandatory throughout the two years of contract period.
- (b) Additional visits must be provided on demand, without any extra charge, in case of operational issues or specific requirements.
- (a) A Logbook / Register shall be maintained by the service engineer, to be signed by the authorised representative of the office after every visit.

3. Response Time for Complaints:

In the event of a breakdown or malfunction, the contractor must ensure that the issue is attended to and resolved within two working days from the time to complaint registration. Failure to do so will entitle this office to engage an alternative authorised service provider, and any associated costs shall be recovered either from the contractor's quarterly payable amount or from their EMD/Security Deposit.

- 4. **Routine/Preventive Maintenance:** Monthly inspection and general cleaning of all water purifiers and water coolers is mandatory, Routine/Preventive maintenance may be carried out during any working days or on holidays after prior intimation to this office.
- 5. **Periodic Replacement frequency of components:** The contractor shall proactively monitor the performance of components and replace them as per the below schedule, even if no visible defect is present, to ensure uninterrupted delivery of potable, water. The details of replaced components shall be duly recorded in the register maintained for this purpose. If instant replacement cannot be made, the same to be carried out within 48 hours from the date of reporting the malfunction/ breakdown. All replaced parts must be OEM or equivalent.

- 6. **Scope of AMC Coverage of Components:** The AMC shall include **preventive and breakdown maintenance** and cover **free repair or replacement** of the following components during the contract period whenever they encounter failure / malfunction.
 - (a) Thermostats
 - (b) Relays
 - (c) Capacitors
 - (d) Input / Output pipes
 - (e) Hose Clips
 - (f) Gas refilling / charging

7. Replacement Clause:

- (a) All parts must be **genuine OEM** (Original Equipment Manufacturer) or equivalent quality certified parts and their invoices may be asked for verification. The replaced parts should carry a minimum warranty of 6 months, as per standard.
- (b) Contractor shall ensure that during the progress of the work, no damage shall occur to installations / equipment due to any reason, if so happens, contractor shall have to repair/replace the same at his own risk and cost.

8. Quality Control & Documentation:

- (a) The firm shall conduct regular quality control inspections on all water purifiers and water coolers covered under the AMC once in every quarter.
- (b) These inspections shall include Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) measurement to assess mineral content and filtration efficiency, testing for bacterial and chemical contamination to ensure compliance with IS 10500 potable water standards, and flow rate measurement to verify operational efficiency and detect potential blockages.
- (c) All test results must be properly recorded, certified and submitted to the department in the prescribed format as follows:-

Any deviation from the standard parameters must be reported immediately along with details of the remedial action taken.

9. **Payment Terms:**

- (a) Payments shall be released on a **Quarterly Basis**, as mutually agreed, upon receipt of the **Satisfactory Service Report** signed by the designated officers.
- (b) Any **applicable penalties** will be deducted from the subsequent payment cycle.
- (c) The contractor must submit **GST Compliant Invoices** along with service reports and spare replacement records.

10. **Penalty Clause**

- (a) A penalty of ₹500.00 per day shall be imposed for delays in emergency service response beyond stipulated timelines without prior written justification.
- (b) Non-compliance with scheduled service visits will result in a **pro-rata deduction** from the contract payment, based on the percentage of missed services.
- (c) Repeated **non-performance** (more than two instances) may trigger termination proceedings.

11. Dispute & Liability

- (a) The contractor shall be **fully liable** for any damage to equipment or office property arising due to negligence or improper handling during service.
- (b) In case of any **dispute regarding liability**, the matter shall be resolved based on documented service reports and Administrative Enquiry.

12. **Termination Clause**

- (a) Either party may terminate the contract by giving a 30 days Written Notice citing valid reasons.
- (b) Immediate termination may be invoked in the event of persistent non-performance, fraudulent practices, or breach of contract terms.
- (c) Upon termination, all dues up to the date of exit shall be settled after submission of final service clearance.

C. Eligibility criteria-cum-Technical Bid (Documents to be uploaded in GeM by the Bidders:

Only those bidders who fulfil all criteria and submit all requisite documents in the prescribed format as detailed in the following clauses, shall be considered for technical financial evaluation under the **LCS** methodology outlined later in this document.

- 1. **Company Registration Certificate:** The bidder must submit a valid certificate of incorporation or registration to establish the entity's legal status as a firm, company, or proprietorship. The bidder must be registered within the **Kamrup (Metro) District of Assam.**
- 2. **PAN & GST Registration:** Copies of Permanent Account Number (PAN) and Goods and Services Tax (GST) registration must be provided for tax compliance and verification purposes.

- 3. **Proof of Registration within the State of Assam:** A valid Trade License, registered under Shops & Establishment Act, or other relevant local registration document showing the firm's operations in Assam must be submitted.
- 4. **Proof of Registered Office in Kamrup (Metro) District:** Documentary evidence such as utility bills, lease agreement, or property ownership documents must be provided to confirm the existence of a functional office in Kamrup (Metro) District in Assam.
- 5. **Experience Certificate in Comprehensive AMC (Minimum 3 Years):** Work completion certificates or letters from clients confirming the bidder's experience in handling CAMC of similar equipment for at least the past 3 years.
- 6. **OEM Authorisation:** A valid authorisation letter from the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) must be furnished if the bidder is not the OEM but is supplying spare parts or providing service on behalf of one.
- 7. **Past Performance Records:** A detailed list mentioning at least 3 major clients, preferably Central / State Government Departments or Central Public Sector Undertaking / State Public Sector Undertaking, with brief descriptions of similar work executed in the past. Such certificates must be certified on the letterhead of the issuing organisation with duration and amount duly mentioned.
- 8. **Declaration of No Blacklisting:** The bidder must submit a notarised affidavit on ₹100.00 Non-Judicial Stamp stating that the firm has not been backlisted or debarred by any Government Agency, PSU, or institutions.
- 9. **Financial Turnover / Income Tax Returns of Last 3 Financial Years:** Copies of Audited Balance Sheets, Profit & Loss Statements, or Income Tax Returns (ITRs) of the last 3 Financial Years viz. 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 must be submitted as a proof of Financial Capability.
- (D) Technical and Financial Evaluation Criteria through Least Cost Selection (LCS) Method: Bidders will be technically evaluated based on the following parameters. Each criterion carries a specified weightage, and the cumulative technical score will determine eligibility for the financial evaluation round.



- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 4. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
- 5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated online in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents. 6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of

quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and

based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

- 7. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -
- 1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
- 2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
- 3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.
- 8. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
