Inviting comments on the proposed amendments to the Recruitment Rules to the posts of Assistant Manager-cum-Store Keeper, Clerk, Halwai-cum-Cook, Assistant Halwai-cum-Cook and Canteen Attendant (Group 'C' posts) in IA&AD Departmental Canteens/Tiffin Rooms.

Indian Audit and Accounts Department proposes to amend Recruitment Rules (RRs) for Group 'C' posts of its Departmental Canteens/ Tiffin Rooms viz. Assistant Manager-cum-Store Keeper (Grade Pay - 2400/-), Clerk (Grade Pay - 1900/-), Halwai-cum-Cook (Grade Pay - 2000/-), Assistant Halwai-cum-Cook (Grade Pay - 1900/-) and Canteen Attendant (Grade Pay - 1800/-). The proposed RRs containing draft Notification and Schedule given/posted below have been framed in accordance with the Model RRs, circulated by the DoP&T vide O.M. No. 3/2/2009-Dir.(C) dated 22.05.2013 as amended vide O.M. No. 3/2/2009-Dir.(C) dated 09.02.2015.

Notification

G.S.R. – In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution, and in suppression of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2001, in so far as they relate to the posts of Manager Grade-III, Store Keeper or Assistant Manager-cum-store-keeper, Cashier, Halwai, Clerk/Salesman, Assistant Halwai, Cook, Tea or Coffee Maker, Bearer and Wash Boy, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President, after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Assistant Manager-cum-Store Keeper, Clerk, Halwai-cum-Cook, Assistant Halwai-cum-Cook and Canteen Attendant in the Departmental Canteens/Tiffin Rooms in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Departmental Canteen) Group 'C' posts Recruitment Rules, 2016.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application. These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed of these rules.
- 3. Number of posts, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.- The number of said posts, their classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 5. Disqualification. No person,-
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Power to relax. Where the Comptroller and Auditor- General of India is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 7. Saving.-Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, exservicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 2.- Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors shall also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.
