FINANCE ACCOUNTS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF RAJASTHAN
FOR THE YEAR 1961-62.

Certificate of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.

This compilation containing the Finance Accounts of the Government of Rajasthan for the year 1961-62 presents the accounts of the receipts and outgoings of the Government for the year, together with the financial results disclosed by the revenue and capital accounts, the accounts of the public debt and the liabilities and assets as worked out from the balances recorded in its books. It supplements the accounts separately presented in the form of Appropriation Accounts for Grants and Charged Appropriations.

These accounts which as Comptroller and Auditor General, I am required to prepare, have been prepared and examined under my direction in accordance with the provisions of the Government of India (Audit and Accounts) Order, 1936, as adapted under the India (Provisional Constitution) Order, 1947, read with Article 149 of the Constitution of India. It is to be noted that the Comptroller and Auditor General's responsibility for the audit of the accounts of the Government does not at present extend in full to the audit of the accounts of revenue, but I am satisfied, on the best information available that the accounts of revenue included in the Finance Accounts herewith presented give a correct statement of the sums brought to account. Subject to these observations and also to those contained in this compilation as well as in the Audit Report, 1963, the accounts now presented are correct statements of the receipts and outgoings of the Government of Rajasthan for the year 1961-62.

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INTRODUCTORY

The Accounts of the Government of Rajasthan are kept in three parts :

- Part I Consolidated Fund
- Part II Contingency Fund
- Part III Public Account

In Part I, there are three main divisions, namely:—

- (1) Revenue ;
- (2) Capital ; and
- (3) Debt (comprising Public Debt and Loans and Advances).

The first division deals with the proceeds of taxation and other receipts classed as revenue and the expenditure therefrom, the net result of which represents the revenue surplus or deficit for the year.

The second division deals with expenditure met usually from borrowed funds with the object either of increasing concrete assets of a material character or of reducing recurring liabilities, such as those for future pensions, by payment of the capitalised value. It also includes receipts of a capital nature intended to be applied as set off against capital expenditure.

The third division comprises loans raised by Government—loans of a purely temporary nature classed as “Floating Debt” (such as Treasury Bills and Ways and Means Advances), as well as other loans classed as “Permanent Debt”—and “Loans and Advances made by Government” together with repayments of the former and recoveries of the latter.

In Part II of the accounts are recorded the transactions connected with the Contingency Fund set up by the Government of Rajasthan under Article 267(2) of the Constitution of India.

In Part III of the accounts, there are two main divisions, namely :—

- (1) Debt (other than those included in Part I) and Deposits ; and
- (2) Remittances.

The first division comprises receipts and payments, other than those falling under Debt heads pertaining to Part I, in respect of which Government incurs a liability to repay the money received or has a claim to recover the amounts paid together with repayments of the former and recoveries of the latter.

The second division embraces all merely adjusting heads under which appear remittances of cash between treasuries and transfers between different accounting circles. The initial debits or credits to the heads in this division are cleared eventually by corresponding receipts or payments either within the same circle of account or in another account circle.

2. *Sections and Heads of Accounts.*—Within each of the divisions mentioned above, the transactions are grouped into Sections which are further sub-divided into Major Heads of Accounts. The Sections are distinguished by letters of alphabet, a single letter denoting the revenue portion and a double letter denoting the capital portion of a particular category of transactions, e.g., Section A denotes the revenue (and expenditure) grouped as “Taxes, Duties and Other Principal Heads of Revenue” and Section AA denotes the capital expenditure on works connected therewith.

3. The Major Heads in the Revenue and Capital divisions are numbered serially Roman numerals being employed on the receipt side and Arabic on the disbursement side. No numbering is adopted for the Contingency Fund and for Debt, Deposit and Remittance heads, though these are also arranged in sections.

4. The Major Heads are sub-divided into Minor Heads and the Minor Heads into sub-heads and Detailed heads. Under each of these heads, the expenditure is shown distributed between Charged and Voted. The Major, Minor and sub-heads prescribed for the classification of expenditure in the general accounts are not necessarily identical with the Grants, Sub-heads and other units of allotments which are adopted by the Finance Department for Demands for Grants but in general, a certain degree of co-relation is maintained between the Demands for Grants and the Finance Accounts.

5. The transactions included in these accounts represent mainly the actual cash receipts and disbursements during the financial year ending 31st March, 1962 as distinguished from the amounts due to or by Government during the same period. The cash basis system is, however, not entirely suitable for recording the transactions and for presenting the true state of affairs of Government commercial undertakings run on commercial principles. The detailed accounts of this class of undertakings are, therefore, maintained outside the regular accounts in commercial form and are subject to a test check by the Indian Audit and Accounts Department.

6. The figures of actuals shown in these accounts are net, after taking into account the recoveries although the Demands presented to the Legislature and the Appropriation Accounts are for gross expenditure and exclude all credits and recoveries which are otherwise taken as reduction of expenditure.

Explanatory Notes.

1. Receipts from the Central Government.—The revenue receipts for the year under review include :—

- (i) Share of net proceeds of Taxes on Income other than Corporation Tax (Rs. 3.81 crores), Union Excise Duties (Rs. 3.13 crores) and Estate Duties (Rs. 16.44 lakhs),
- (ii) Grants in lieu of Tax on Railway Passenger Fares (Rs. 84.63 lakhs),
- (iii) Grants-in-aid received from the Central Government under Article 275 of the Constitution (Rs. 2.76 crores), and

(iv) Other Grants received from the Government of India for different purposes (Rs. 6.28 crores).

2. *Taxation changes during the year.*—During the year, the existing rates of Sales Tax, Excise Duties, Surcharge on non-judicial stamp duty, Entertainment Tax and Taxes on private motor cars and on passengers and goods carried by motor vehicles were increased; no new tax was levied.

3. *Revenue Receipts.*—The increase in revenue receipts from Rs. 43.96 crores in 1960-61 to Rs. 46.21 crores in the year under review was mainly under the heads:—

- (a) "Taxes on Income other than Corporation Tax" (due to larger assignment of share of Income Tax by the Central Government),
- (b) "Land Revenue" (due to increase in cultivated area and income from Jagirs resumed),
- (c) "Sales Tax" (on account of general rise in prices and larger consumption of taxable articles as well as collection of arrears) and
- (d) "Extraordinary Items" (due to increased sale of land), partly set off by shortfalls under
- (e) "Miscellaneous" (due mainly to more refunds than originally anticipated) and
- (f) "Contributions and Miscellaneous Adjustments" (due to less subventions and grants received from the Central Government).

4. *Expenditure on Revenue Account.*—The increase in expenditure on revenue account from Rs. 45.46 crores in 1960-61 to Rs. 52.00 crores in the year under review was mainly under the following heads:—

No law has been passed by the Legislature of the State under the provisions of Article 293 of the Constitution laying down the limit within which Government may borrow on the security of the Consolidated Fund of the State.

Explanatory Notes

1. *Permanent Debt*.—This category covers long term loans raised from the open market to finance certain projects. During the year, a loan of Rs. 4.40 crores bearing interest at $4\frac{1}{4}$ per cent was raised at a discount of $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. This loan is redeemable at par in 1972.

Full particulars of the outstanding loans will be found in Statement No. 17 (at pages 85—88).

Arrangements for Amortisation.—There are no regular arrangements for the amortisation of loans. During the year 1960-61 a sum of Rs. 19 lakhs was appropriated from the revenues to the Sinking Fund created for redemption of permanent loans and this amount was invested by Government in securities of the Gujarat Development Loan, 1969.

A further sum of Rs. 22.31 lakhs was also appropriated from the revenues to the Fund during the year under report but this amount has not been invested so far.

The balance in the Fund at the end of 1961-62 was Rs. 22.69 lakhs (*vide* Statement No. 16).

A sum of Rs. 1.37 lakhs was adjusted from revenue during the year for reduction or avoidance of debt. This in effect increased the revenue deficit and did not signify any real saving from revenue.

2. *Floating Debt*.—This represents borrowings of a purely temporary character viz., Ways and Means advances from the State Bank of India and the Reserve Bank of India and temporary overdrafts from other Banks conducting Government Treasury business.

3. *Loans from the Central Government*.—The Government of Rajasthan did not consider any amortisation arrangement necessary for repayment of loans taken from the Central Government as 'no arrangements are possible

for amortisation of loans until real surpluses appear on Revenue Account'. A Statement of loans taken by the State Government is given in Statement No. 17 at pages 85—88.

An aggregate amount of Rs. 6.75 crores was received by the State Government during 1961-62 as Ways and Means Advance for Plan Schemes, of which Rs. 4.43 crores had been adjusted as loan and Rs. 2.32 crores as grant. This loan has been included in the total loan of Rs. 46.82 crores received during 1961-62.

4. *Other Loans.*—Particulars of the outstanding loans will be found in Statement No. 17 at pages 85—88.

5. *Unfunded Debt.*—This item comprises the Provident Fund balances of the Government servants. It also includes balances under Savings Bank Deposits and State Government Insurance Fund.

The gross interest charges paid during the year under report (excluding contribution to the Sinking Fund and Other Appropriations) work out to 11.23 per cent of the revenues of the State. The net interest charges paid during the year under review (i. e., after taking into account the interest realised by Government on loans and advances made by them and allowing for the amount of interest capitalised) amounted to Rs. 3.65 crores which works out to 7.90 per cent of the revenues for that year.

Explanatory Notes

Under an agreement with the Reserve Bank of India, the Government of Rajasthan have to maintain a minimum balance of Rs. 7 lakhs on Fridays and not less than Rs. 6 lakhs on other days. The Bank informs Government by telegram of their daily balance with it at the close of each working day. If this balance falls on weekly settling days below the agreed minimum, the deficiency is made good either by taking a "Ways and Means" advance from the Reserve Bank or by selling Treasury bills.

A Ways and Means Advance of Rs. 14 lakhs was obtained from the Reserve Bank of India on one occasion and interest at 3 per cent amounting to Rs. 20,942 was paid thereon during 1961-62. Interest at the same rate amounting to Rs. 20,762 was also paid during the year on a Ways and Means Advance of Rs. 14 lakhs obtained from the Bank during 1960-61. Ways and Means Advances amounting to Rs. 1,77.61 lakhs were also obtained from the State Bank of India against securities pledged with it and interest at 5 per cent amounting to Rs. 15.54 lakhs was paid during 1961-62.

An amount of Rs. 38.84 lakhs was also paid during the year to the Reserve Bank of India as interest at rates varying from 3 to 4 per cent for the shortfall in the balance during the week days.

No Treasury Bills were issued during the year.

The cash business of the Government of Rajasthan is, at certain places, carried on by the State Bank of India and its subsidiaries, viz., the State Bank of Jaipur and the State Bank of Bikaner, as agents to the Reserve Bank of India; the Bank of Rajasthan Ltd., and the Punjab National Bank Ltd., through their local branches. Except the State Bank of India and its subsidiaries which act on behalf of the Reserve Bank, the other Banks charge and are being charged interest for the money drawn or credited in excess of the agreed limits as the case may be. The moneys drawn in excess from the Banks are made good by Government either by floating Treasury Bills or by drawing upon their Bank account with the State Bank of India or by obtaining temporary over-drafts from other Banks conducting Government Treasury business. The excess drawals from Banks during 1961-62 were made good by obtaining loans from the Reserve Bank of India.

Explanatory Notes

1. The significance of the head "Government Account" is explained in Note 5 below. The other headings in this summary take into account the balances under all account heads in Government books in regard to which Government has a liability to repay the moneys received or has a claim to recover the amounts paid and also heads of account opened in the books for adjustment of Remittance transactions. It must be understood that these balances cannot be regarded as a complete record of the financial position of the Government of Rajasthan as it does not take into account all the physical assets of the State, such as Lands, Buildings, Communications, etc., nor any accrued dues or outstanding liabilities which are not brought to account under the cash basis of accounting followed by Government.

2. Subject to the remarks in Note 3 below, the balances, whether in cash or investments, under each head have been duly verified and found to agree with those shown in the separate registers or other records maintained in the Accounts Office for the purpose in accordance with the prescribed rules. The debits and credits during the year to the different Reserve Funds and Deposit Accounts were for amounts authorised by the relevant Acts or Rules of the Funds or Accounts, and there were no diversions for purposes other than those for which the Funds were constituted or the grants were made.

3. A summary of receipts, disbursements and balances under Debt, Deposit, Remittances and Contingency Fund is given in Statement No. 16.

In a number of cases, (indicated with mark* in Statement No.16) there are unreconciled differences in the closing balance as reported in that Statement and that shown in the separate registers or other records maintained in the Accounts Office/Departmental Offices for the purpose. Steps are being taken to settle the discrepancies as soon as possible. In some cases the full details and documents required for the purpose are awaited from the Departmental/Treasury Officers as detailed in Annexure III of this compilation.

The balances are communicated to the officers concerned every year for acceptance thereof. In a large number of cases such acceptances have not been received.

The following are instances where the verification and acceptance of balances involving large amounts have been delayed. In many cases the delay extends over several years.

Adjustments consequent on States Reorganisation Act, 1956.

4. Under the States Reorganisation Act, 1956, certain balances under Debt, Deposit and Remittances heads are to be transferred from the accounts of the Government of Madhya Pradesh and the erstwhile Ajmer State to the accounts of the Government of Rajasthan. These adjustments have not so far been carried out for want of necessary information from the Rajasthan Government. The matter is under correspondence.

Government Account.

5. Under the system of book-keeping followed in the Indian Government Accounts the amounts booked under revenue, capital and other transactions of Government in respect of which the balances are not carried forward from year to year in the accounts, are closed to a single head called "Government Account". The balance under this head represents the cumulative result of all such transactions so that after adding thereto the balances under Debt, Deposit, Remittance heads and Contingency Fund, the closing cash balance at the end of the year may be worked out and proved.
