**Note:**

2. In column 10 should be shown:
  - (i) Whether the property has been acquired by purchase, mortgage or lease the price of premium for such acquisition.
  - (ii) Where it has been acquired on lease, the total annual rent thereof also, and
  - (iii) Where the acquisition is by inheritance, gift or exchange, the approximate value of the property so acquired.
