2. Eligibility:

- (i) Sportspersons who have represented a State or the Country in a National (Senior/Junior Category) or International competitions (Senior/Junior Category) in any Game/Sports mentioned at serial number 1 above. or
- (ii) Sportspersons who have represented their University in All India Inter-University Tournaments conducted by the Inter-University Sports Board in any Game/Sports mentioned at serial number 1 above.

3. Scale of Pay:

- a. Auditor/Accountant: Level 5 in the Pay Matrix (Pre-revised Pay in the Pay Band Rs. 5200-20200 with Grade Pay Rs 2800/-)
- b. Clerk: Level 2 in the Pay Matrix (Pre-revised Pay in the Pay Band Rs. 5200-20200 with Grade Pay Rs 1900/-)
- c. DEO-Grade-A: Level 4 in the Pay Matrix (Pre-revised Pay in the Pay Band Rs. 5200-20200 with Grade Pay Rs 2400/-)

4. Educational Qualification:

- Auditor/Accountant: Bachelor's Degree of a recognised University.
- b. Clerk/DEO-Grade-A: 12th class or equivalent qualification from a recognised Board or University. The persons selected for the post of Clerk will have to qualify the Typing Test after appointment. The persons selected for the post of Auditor/Accountant will have to qualify the Departmental Confirmatory Test for Auditor/Accountant within two years from the date of their appointment. Failure to pass the typing test (for clerk) and confirmatory test (for Auditor/ Accountant) will render the Clerk/Auditor/Accountant, as the case may be,liable for discharge from service.

5. Age:

 - **b.** Field trials of the candidates will be conducted to assess their sports performance and suitability for IA&AD Team. Field Trials would consist of Fitness and Skill Tests.
 - i. Fitness Test: During field trials, Fitness Test will be conducted first. The Selection Committee will conduct the Fitness Test and adjudge the candidates and award the marks as per Annexure-VII (i to v). If any candidate secures less than 40% marks in Fitness Test, she/he will not be considered for the skill Test.
 - ii. **Skill Test**: During the Skill Test performance of the candidates will be adjudged separately and marks will be awarded as per **Annexure-VII** (vi to ix).
- 8. Probation period: All persons appointed against sports quota shall be under probation for a period of two years from the date of appointment. Before completion of probation, the performance of the sportspersons shall be reviewed. If the performance of the person recruited under sports quota is considered unsatisfactory, her/his probation shall be extended for a maximum of two years, and the person will have to improve her/his performance to get confirmed. If even after the extended probation, the performance is found unsatisfactory, then normal procedure for removal from service shall be followed.
- 9. All India Service Liability: Candidates selected for appointment shall be liable to serve anywhere in India.
- 10. Resolution of Tie Cases: In case more than one sportsperson scores the same marks, preference will be given to the younger candidate to decide the merit.
- 11. Courts' Jurisdiction: Any dispute in regard to this recruitment will be subject to courts/tribunals having jurisdiction over the City/Town in which the concerned Nodal Office is situated and where the candidate has submitted his/her application.

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
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INDIA@75: GANDHIJI'S UNDYING RELEVANCE

Professor N Radhakrishnan

How does one explain the phenomenon of having the power to altract an estimated number of over 30,000 people every day to the Gandhi Memorial at Raighat in Delhi where the Father of the Nation was consigned to flames? Among those who come there are men and women, children, youth, physically challenged, people of all religions, diplomats, Heads of foreign nations and people from all walks of life. They don't come like tourists but come like pilgrims of peace and harmony. The eyes of many well with tears as they go round the marble slabs to pay their respects to the prophet of peace. Once when this writer ventured to ask what their impressions were on visiting the final resting place of the Mahatma, two young greater violence. The miracle Gandhi men who came from the rural depths of Bihar said. 'He died for us. This is a place of Inspiration and introspection for us."

There is no reason to disbelieve these young men. Gandhi stood like a sentinel between the warring communities and



groups. By shedding his blood at the after of communal harmony, Gandhi effected a truce which acted like a cementing force. Gendhi taught that violence begets achieved in Noakhal and other places where men had become beasts is part of history and his lead continues to inspire a considerable segment of Indian masses as well as human rights activists, freedom ensuring of social justice and employment fighters and those who seek alternative opportunities to millions of youth are

I hate distinction between foreign and indigenous," the Mahatma wrote on his vision of an India.

SARDAR PATEL THE CHAMPION OF A UNITED INDIA

s india celebrates National Unity Day Aon October 31, it is an apportune time to revisit the enduring contribution of Sardar Patel in the multi-dimensional task of nation-building post-partition and postindependence. The India we know today as a single geographical entity is the gift of Patel When we say "from Kashmir to Kanyakumari, India is one," we essentially pay tribute to Patel leading the arduous task of unifying India. If Gandhi lent his leadership to free India from foreign rule. Patel led its unification. Without a united India, we as a nation would have lost the whole meaning of Independence

When the British left India, our leaders faced the task of cobbling up unity in a fragmented geography. The task to integrate 565 big and small princely states was an difficult one, requiring sagacity, firmness and political skills of a high order Patel was the man of the moment and he indeed rose to the occasion. He was a natural choice to be made the first Home Minister of India, which allowed him to boister India's internal security and build a strong and united India. Patel was also



the Constituent Assembly, viz: the Advisory Committee and the Provincial Constitution Committee. His credentials in leading peasants and crafting the

Chairman of two important committees of Constitution of India were, thus, well established. It was clear in everyone's mind that integration of princely states could be accomplished only by Patel because he had earned a reputation for

being decisive and dealing with any challenging situation with an "iron hand." it is hard to imagine how the intractable princely states would have been unified as a single nation without a colossal leader like Patel. India was indeed fortunate to have a man cut out for the lob, and he performed the job with surgical precision.

Different tasks: Different leaders

The making of a nation is not an Individual project. It requires more than one to accomplish the complex task of building a nation on solid foundations. The first task i.e. securing Independence from British rule, was left to Gandhi. He led a powerful non-violent national movement against the British, finally compelling them to grant Independence and leave India to indians. But then cropped up the issue of uniting the princely states, and Patel handled this with an iron hand. The third task was to build democratic institutions modern industries, and align India well with the rest of the world through a rational foreign policy, a job for which Nehru was the chosen man.


